Your responsibilities as Psychologist will include providing psycho-educational, psychological/diagnostic, and forensic/risk assessments, evidenced-based individual therapy (with Dialectical Behaviour Therapy as the primary modality), limited group therapy and DBT Skills Training to Syl Apps residents ranging from 12 to 18 years of age. As a member of a multi-disciplinary team, your duties will include participating in Plan of Care and Treatment Plan conferences, providing staff consultation and assisting with staff training related to psychological interventions.

The successful candidate must have a Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology and be registered with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Candidates in the process of registration with the College who anticipate becoming supervised practice members within 6 months of their employment date with Kinark will be considered. Clinical experience working with youth who present with complex mental health issues and/or youth involved with the Youth Justice System would be assets. Strong clinical assessment and treatment skills, demonstrated clinical leadership, proven communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work effectively as a team member will be significant position requirements. Experience with Dialectical Behaviour Therapy will be considered an asset, otherwise education will be provided. Knowledge concerning cultural diversity will also be considered an asset for this position.
